Headteacher's Message

Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope you all had a restful break and are looking forward to the exciting and action-packed summer term ahead. As we prepare to welcome the children back tomorrow, here are some important reminders to ensure everyone is ready for the term:

Sun Safety

With the weather warming up, it's essential to keep our children protected from the sun:

- **Sunscreen:** Please apply sunscreen to your child before they come to school. If needed, they may bring a named bottle for self-application during the day.
- **Sun Hats:** Ensure your child brings a sun hat to school each day to shield them from direct sunlight.
- **Water Bottles:** Staying hydrated is crucial. Please provide your child with a water bottle daily.

PE Kit

PE sessions may vary throughout the term, so it's important that children have their PE kits in school every day. This ensures they can participate fully in all physical activities.

Forest School Attire

For those attending Forest School sessions:

- **Clothing:** Regardless of the temperature, children should wear long trousers and long-sleeved tops to protect against scratches, stings, and ticks. Lightweight fabrics are acceptable to keep them cool.
- **Changing Clothes:** On particularly hot days, children may come to school in their regular summer uniform and change into their Forest School attire before the session.

Footwear

- We understand that at this time of year, children may have outgrown their school shoes. Recognizing that purchasing new formal shoes can be costly, especially with the summer holidays approaching, we do not expect you to rush out and replace them immediately. However, we kindly

ask that children wear respectable footwear that aligns as closely as possible with our uniform policy—preferably plain, dark-coloured trainers without prominent logos or bright colours.
